Evolution of the Mushrooms imports and exports flows inside and outside EU

Updated April 2024 from
EUROSTAT 2023 data



Reminder: asymmetries can exist between exports from a country A to B and imports of B from A for a same product.

This is because of national rules for customs declarations. The mandatory declaration thresholds are not the same between Member States.

Eurostat data analysis remains relevant in terms of evolution rather than absolute value.

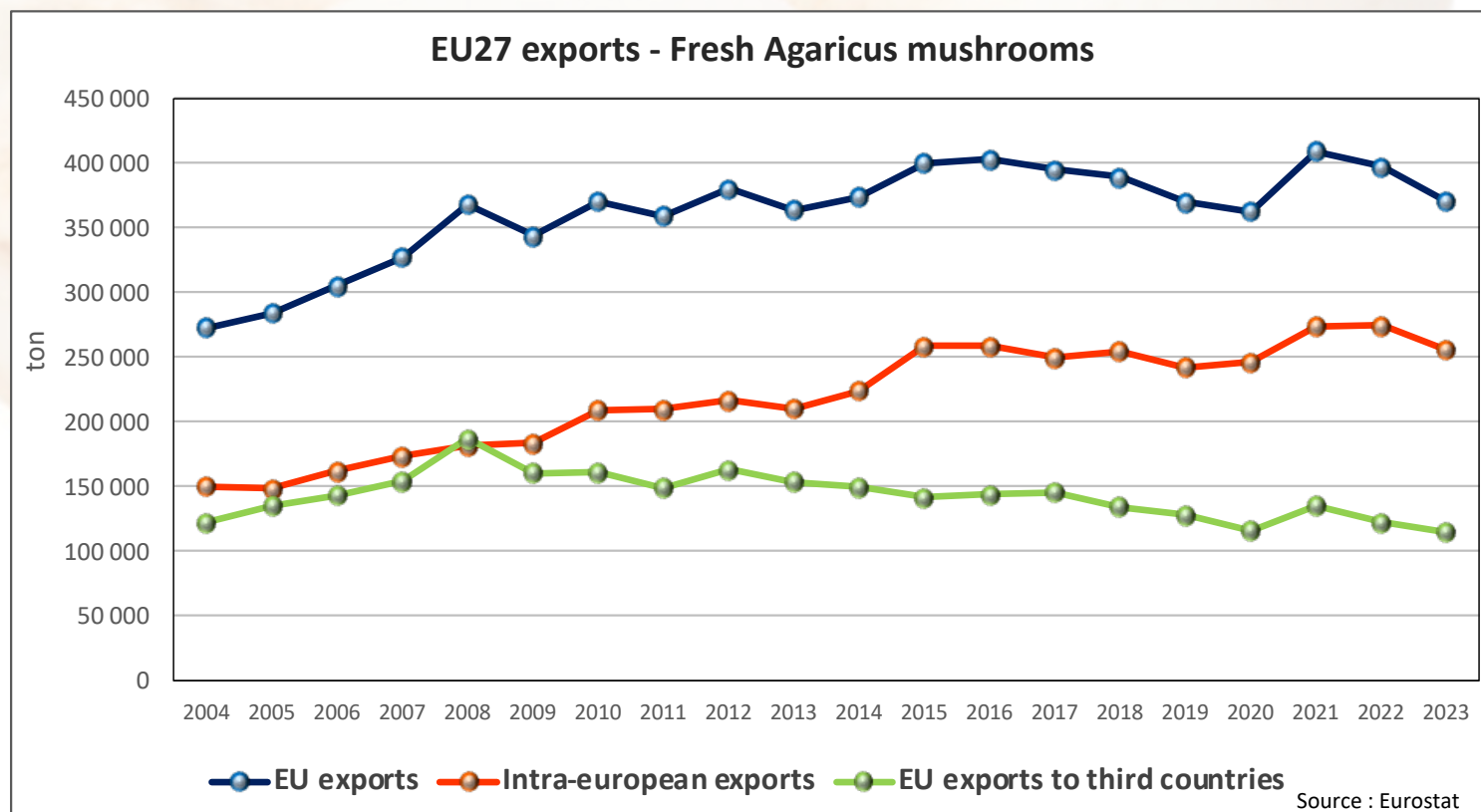


Fresh Agaricus mushrooms

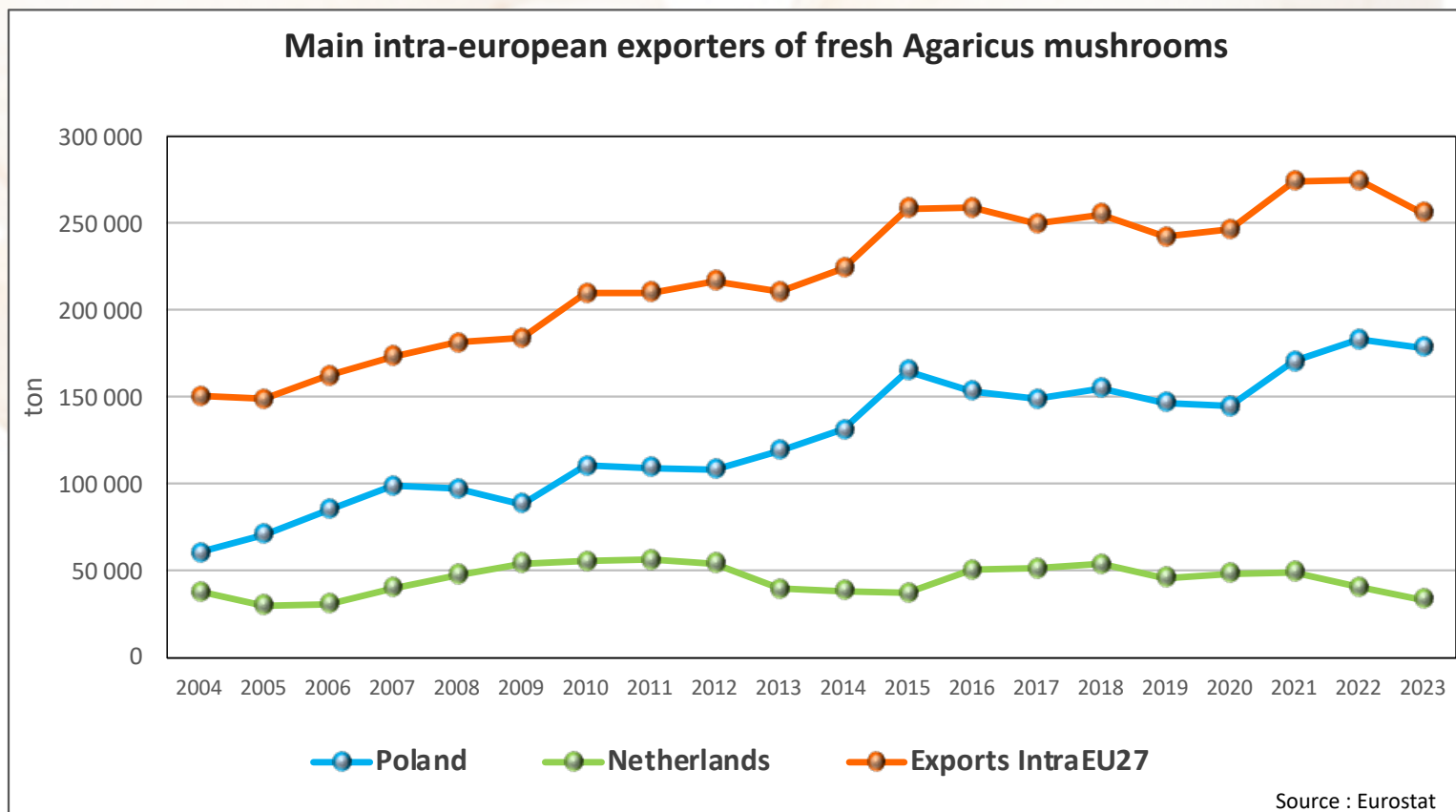
Fresh Agaricus mushrooms

- Intra-european exports of fresh Agaricus mushrooms are predominant.
- 80% of EU exports of fresh Agaricus mushrooms to third countries are destined to the UK.



Fresh Agaricus mushrooms

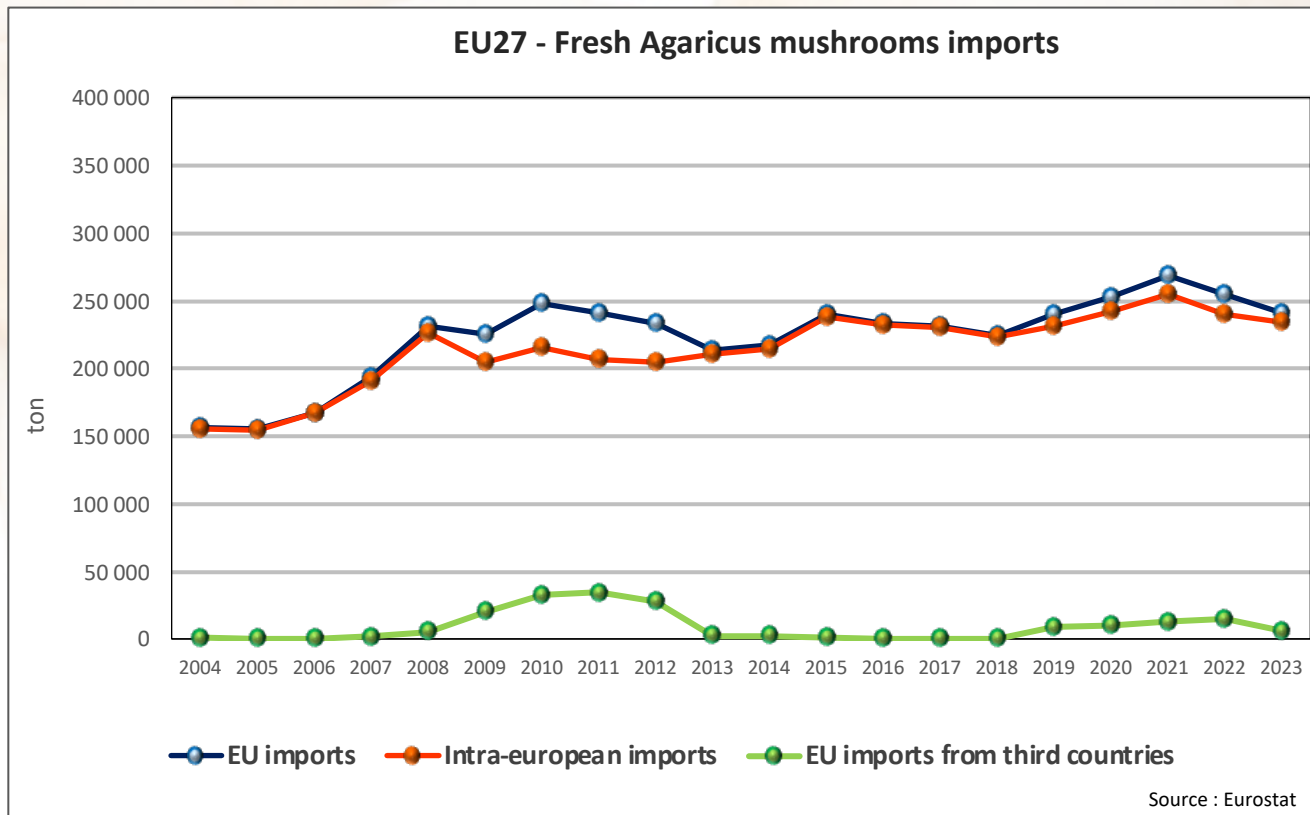
- Poland is by far the 1st European exporter of fresh Agaricus mushrooms to EU27.



Fresh Agaricus mushrooms

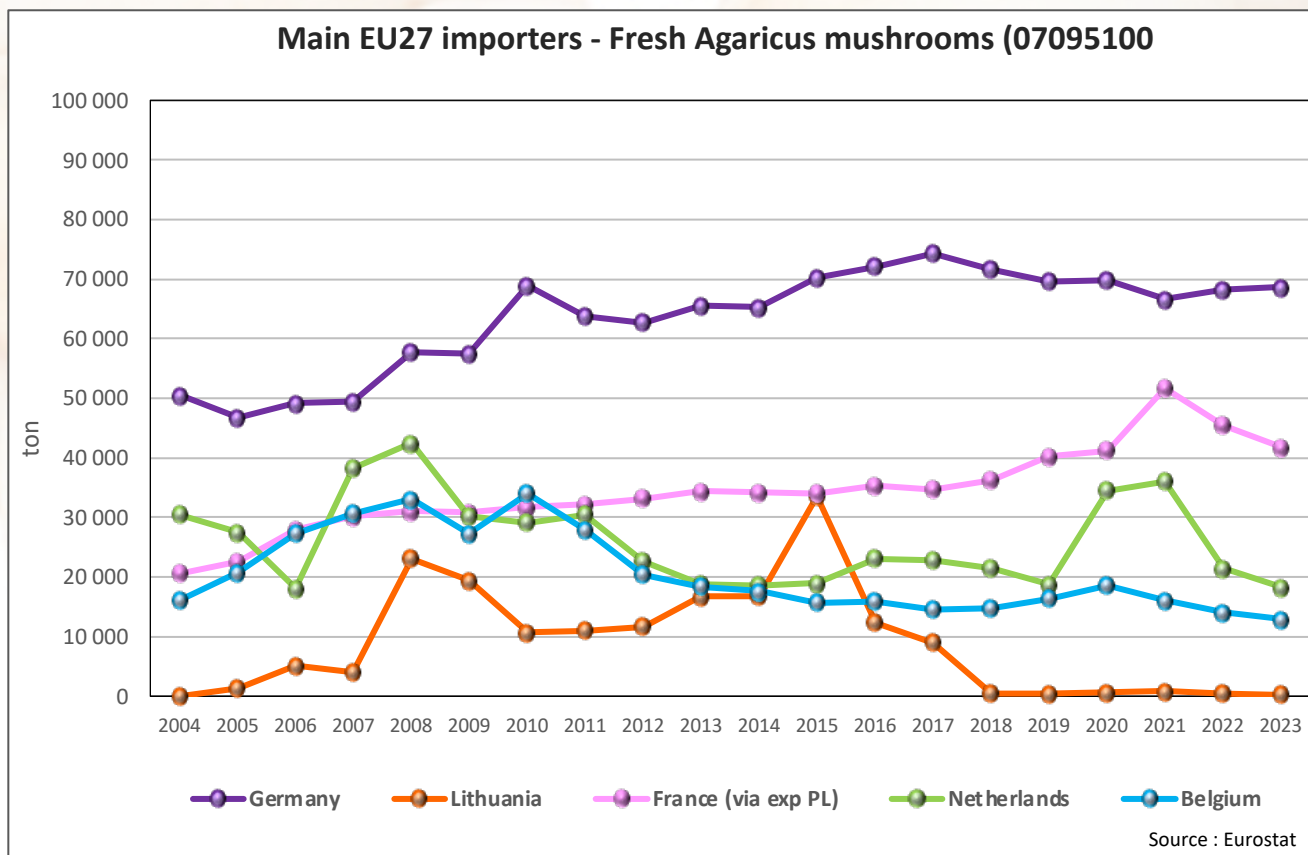


- **There are very few European imports** of fresh Agaricus mushrooms from third countries. The EU27 can be considered self-sufficient for fresh Agaricus mushrooms.



Fresh Agaricus mushrooms

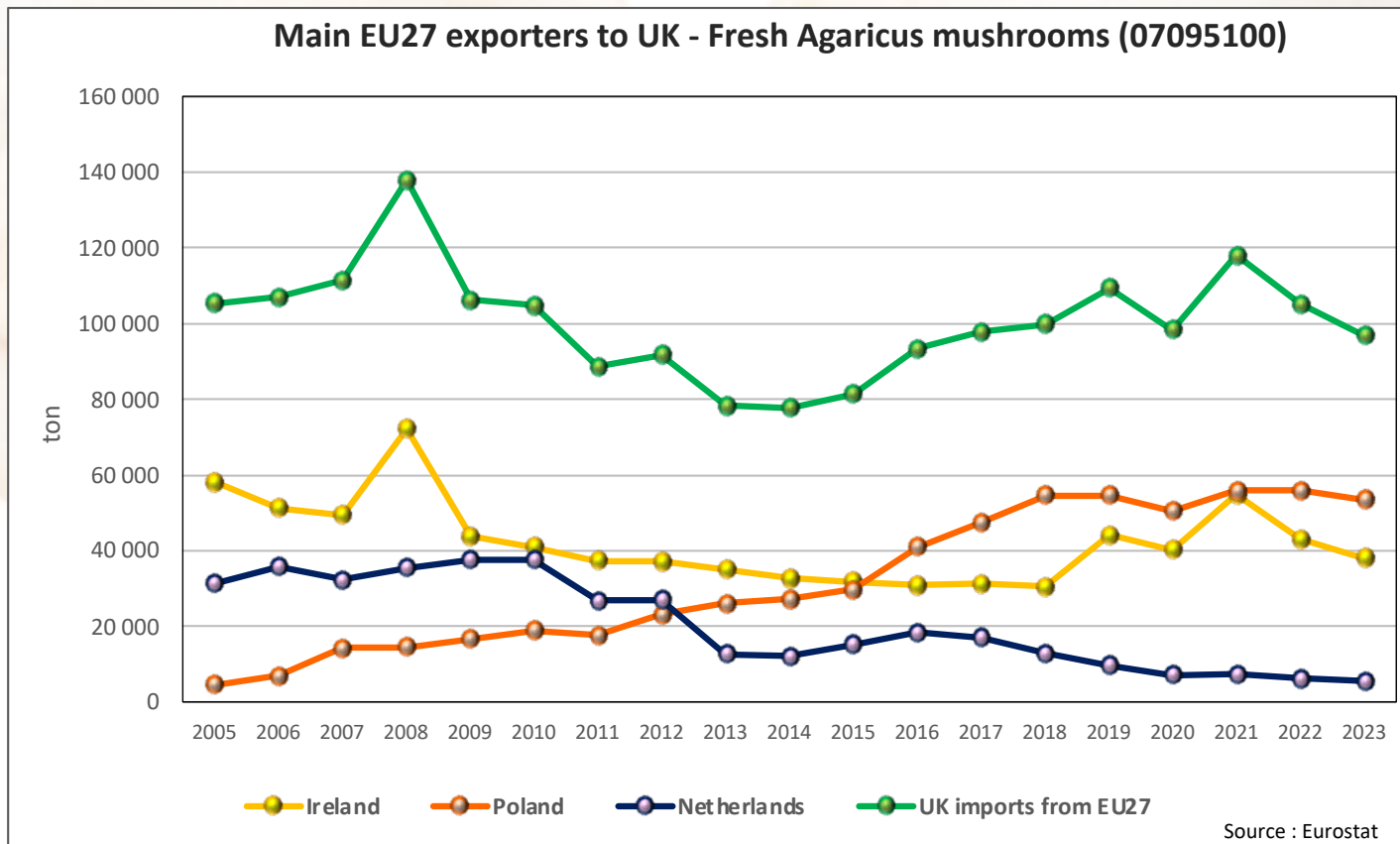
- Germany and France are the main European importers of fresh Agaricus mushrooms.

- **UK is the main third country importer of fresh Agaricus mushrooms, coming essentially from Poland and Ireland.**





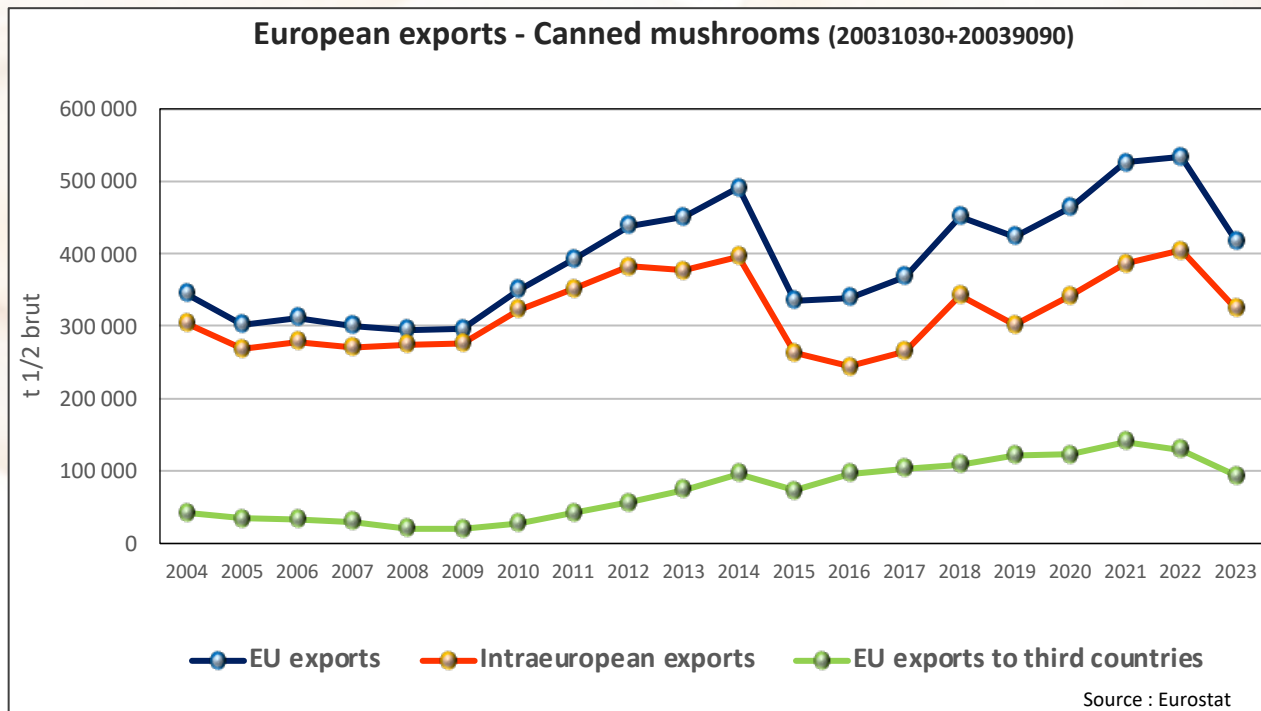
Canned mushrooms

Canned mushrooms

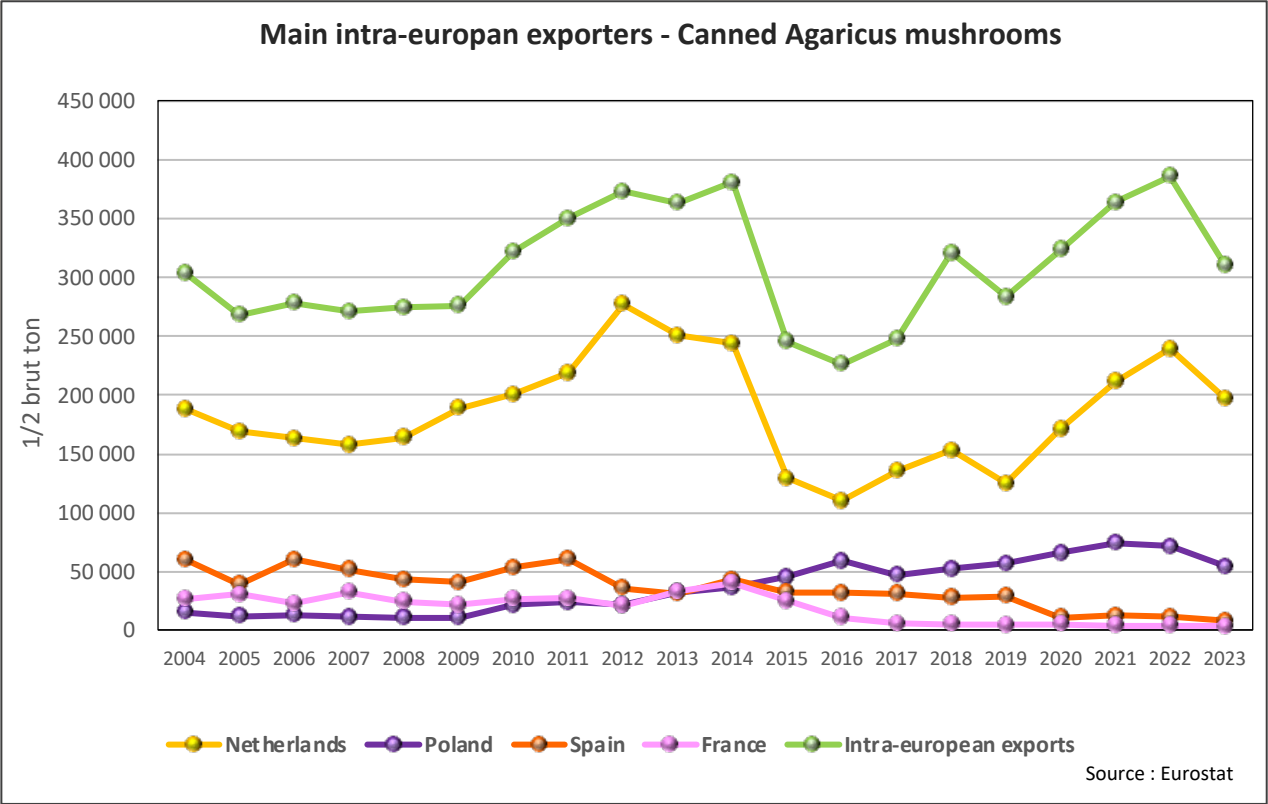


- **EU exports** of canned mushrooms are mainly intra-European.
- **EU exports to third countries** kept on decreasing in 2022.

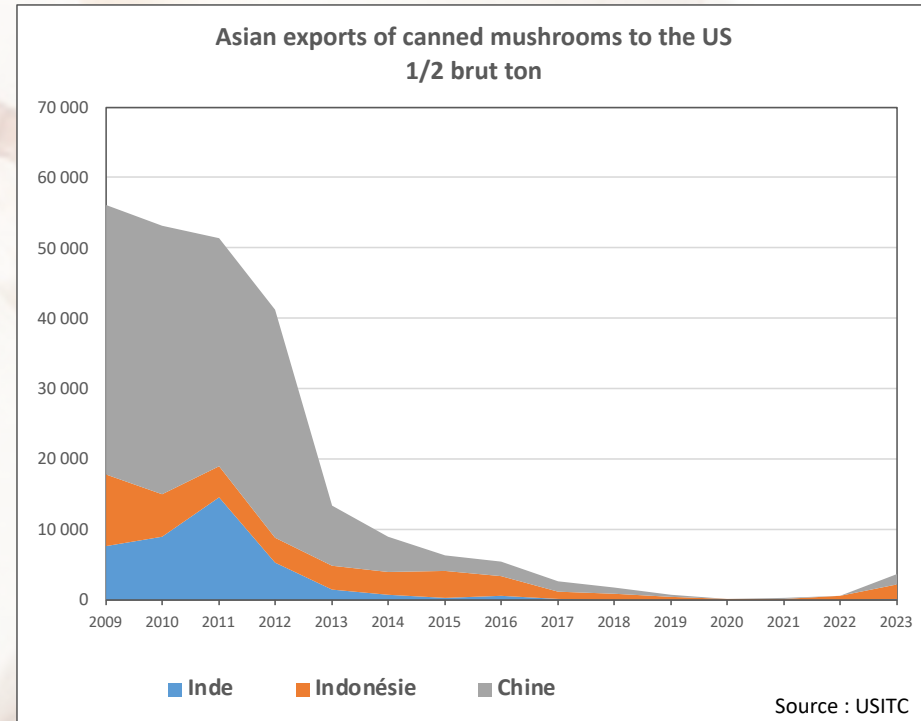
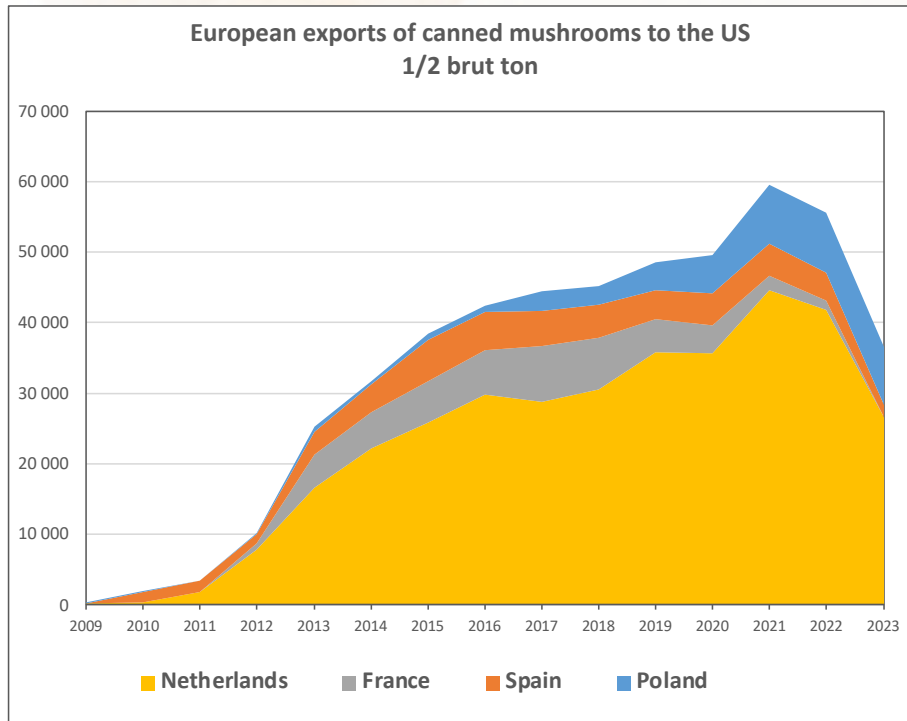
- **The Netherlands are the 1st exporter** of canned Agaricus mushrooms to EU27 countries.



Canned mushrooms



- **EU27 exports** of canned mushrooms to the USA dropped since 2022 due to duty imports applied by the USA whereas the exports of the Asian countries to the USA kept on decreasing.

Detailed codes used in this document



- 07 09 51 00:** Fresh or chilled mushrooms of the genus "Agaricus"
- 07 09 59 90:** Fresh or chilled edible mushrooms (excl. chanterelles, flap mushrooms, mushrooms of the genus "Agaricus" and truffles)
- 20 03 10 30:** Mushrooms of the genus Agaricus, prepared or preserved otherwise than by vinegar or acetic acid (excl. completely cooked mushrooms and provisionally preserved mushrooms)
- 20 03 90 90:** Mushrooms, prepared or preserved otherwise than by vinegar or acetic acid (excl. mushrooms of the genus "Agaricus")
- 07 10 80 61:** Frozen mushrooms of the genus Agaricus, uncooked or cooked by steaming or by boiling in water
- 07 10 80 69:** Frozen mushrooms, uncooked or cooked by steaming or by boiling in water (excl. of the genus Agaricus)
- 07 11 51 00:** Mushrooms of the genus "Agaricus", provisionally preserved, e.g., by sulphur dioxide gas, in brine, in sulphur water or in other preservative solutions, but unsuitable in that state for immediate consumption
- 07 11 59 00:** Mushrooms and truffles, provisionally preserved, e.g., by sulphur dioxide gas, in brine, in sulphur water or in other preservative solutions, but unsuitable in that state for immediate consumption (excl. mushrooms of the genus "Agaricus")
- 06 02 90 10:** Mushroom spawn
